

Airmyn Jubilee Group Annual Report for year ending 2014.

In September 2014 the Jubilee Group disbanded due to lack of interest from the village in the form of volunteers to help organise events and participants for future events. It was thought that the Airmyn Community Association would be in a good position to carry on the work of the group, starting with the popular Bingo afternoons. The sessions have started again under the ACA and are proving a success with the older generation of the village. They are currently held on the first Tuesday of the month, 2.30-4pm in the Memorial Hall.

Throughout the three year lifespan of the Jubilee Group the profits went towards many projects within Airmyn village including a free celebration of the Queens Diamond Jubilee day with free attractions on the playing field, music, ice creams and celebratory mugs for village children and older generations. Planting bulbs in the playing field, creation of the Jubilee Wood, plants for the Clock Tower gardens, afternoon tea for the residential home residents, picnic benches for the play area, a gala day with free attractions and music, rockery plants for the Memorial Hall entrance and a contribution towards fencing around the bowls club.
